

ORDER

The above referenced case has been called for trial on the morning of January 8th 2007 at 8:30 am. In order for the defendant to be properly attired for trial, it is hereby ordered as followed:

The Defendant shall be allowed access to her cosmetics, toiletries, hair dryer, and other essential items that she needs to dress and prepare for court. The Defendant's family will provide these items to the Forsyth County Sheriff's Department on either Friday, January 5th or Saturday, January 6th, 2007. The Defendant's family will also provide the Sheriff's Department with the items of clothing that she will wear during the course of the trial. The Sheriff's Department has the right to search all the items provided for security purposes. It is the intent of this Court by way of this Order to ensure that the Defendant is properly attired and presentable for all of her court appearances.




