STATE'S DEMAND FOR RECIPROCAL DISCOVERY

COMES NOW THE STATE OF GEORGIA, by the District Attorney and again makes demand upon defendant for any and all reciprocal discovery for which the state is entitled, and more specifically as follows:

1.

Counsel for defendant, Mr. Jimmy Berry, indicated to Counsel for the State, Assistant District Attorney Jack Mallard on January 16, 2007, that the defense will probably reuse the expert from the Cobb trial, Dr. Rob Palmer. However, this witness' name and information was not furnished before the Cobb trial, and the present witness list by defendant does not contain an address for this witness. Other possible experts do not likewise contain an address, etc. [See previous demand on December 29, 2006].

The State needs the name, full address, and phone numbers for Dr. Palmer, and any experts, or others expected to testify for the defense. We don't insist on dates of birth, but we do need full names, addresses, and phone numbers. .

3.


The State also is again requesting any written reports, or summaries of oral reports, of any expert witnesses to be used.
