IN RE: TRIALS – SEATS WITHIN THE BAR

Except by permission of the Court, only members of the Bar, officers of the Court, parties, and jurors actually engaged in the trial shall use the seats within the bar of the Court. Any such permission must be requested and granted prior to trial and shall not be requested in the presence of the jury. It shall be the duty of the Sheriff's Department and Bailiffs to see that this Rule is enforced without special Order of the Court.
