Reilly, Chief Judge, Juvenile Court, Appalachian Judicial Circuit and mutually request the permanent judicial assistance of the other, in accordance with O.C.G.A. §15-1-9.1 (2)(D), for the following reasons:

The Appalachian Judicial Circuit is a circuit consisting of two superior court judges and one part time juvenile judge. There will be occasions when these judges, of necessity, will be absent from the office due to mandatory continuing educational seminars, meetings, illnesses, vacation, and for other unforeseen reasons and circumstances. There will also be matters from which the judges will be forced to disqualify themselves which may necessitate immediate action.
