IN RE: CITIZEN REVIEW PANEL AND CASA

In order to provide proper notice and in the interest of justice, the Court hereby orders the following:

1. All recommendations and communications to the Court concerning the merits of any case made by an attorney guardian ad litem, court appointed special advocate or Citizen Review Panel member shall be in writing and made available to all parties and counsel. The juvenile court administrator will notify counsel that a report will be available for review in the judge's conference room. In the event reports are not received until the day of the hearing, counsel shall be allowed an opportunity to review them before the hearing and due consideration will be given to any motion for continuance based upon the need to subpoena any witness named in such report.
2. Attorneys shall be provided with notice of any Citizen Review Panel report concerning their client(s).
