INTERNAL OPERATING PROCEDURE 2000-45

IN RE: REFUNDS OF CRIMINAL CASH BONDS

The Clerk of the Superior Court is hereby authorized to pay and/or refund from the Court Registry the amount of cash bonds deposited by an accused and/or the person making the deposit for the accused after one of the following occurs:

- a. The state dead docketed or administratively dismisses a warrant against an accused prior to indictment or the filing of an accusation by the District Attorney or his representative;
- b. The nolle prosequi of a criminal action against the accused;
- c. The dead docketing of a criminal action against the accused by the order of the court;
- d. Upon the final conviction or acquittal of the accused;
- e. When the bonding company comes off bond as evidenced by a signed affidavit of custody filed in the Clerk's office.
