IN RE: RESTITUTION WHERE MORE THAN ONE DEFENDANT

When restitution is set by one judge in a case with multiple defendants, the restitution amount set by the initial judge in each count will be used by any subsequent judge sentencing a co-defendant. This internal operating procedure includes cases where a juvenile is a co-defendant with an adult.

Further, in cases involving more than one defendant, when restitution is ordered and assessed against one defendant, all convicted co-defendants are jointly and severally liable unless otherwise specified in the sentence.
