IN RE: TRIALS – RETENTION OF COURT REPORTER’S NOTES AND EXHIBITS

In civil cases in which no appeal is filed, or after the time for appeal has expired, or in the event of appeal, thirty (30) days after final disposition of the appeal, the Court Reporter shall notify the parties that all documents and physical evidence admitted at trial should be picked up and returned to the interested parties. If said materials have not been removed from the Court Reporter’s possession at the end of the twentieth (20th) day after due notification, the Court Reporter may request the Court to issue an Order directing the destruction of such material.
